RIDE INTO NATURE'S CANVAS

Discover the Ten Most Scenic Highways in the US for Fall Foliage

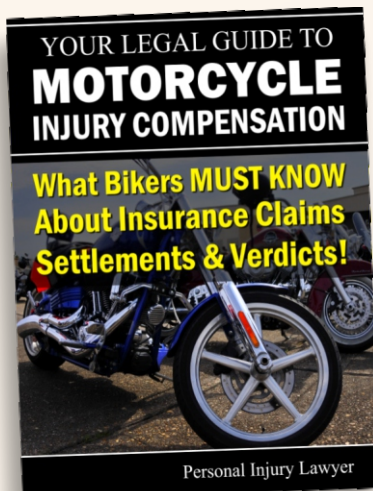
