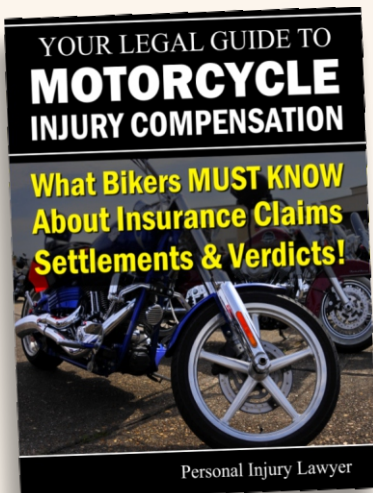
Safety and Compliance:
