2022 is proving to be a banner year for innovative technology, including Motorcycle Gadgets designed make your rides safer, and more stress free. Tim Huber, with Hiconsumptin, has put together a detailed list of some of the best new products on the market.

(1) Earpiece Moto Ear Plugs:

If you've booked some miles on the open freeway then you know that wind noise inside your helmet can be a real problem. With decibels hitting 100db, this can lead to permanent hearing loss. Regular earplugs may cut down on the damaging wind noise, but they also block out road sounds you need to hear. Earpiece Moto's plugs use noise cancelling filter technology to eliminate ambient wind and engine sounds but still let in road sounds like screeching tires, blowing horns and the likes. 2) Signal Dynamics Back Off XP Brake Light Modulator:

This nifty gadget is more than just a cool light show. By repeatedly flashing whenever you activate your front or rear brakes, it will significantly improve your visibility to surrounding drivers. (Suggested Price \$48.00)





◀ 3) Battery Tender USB Charger:

Although today's new bikes come outfitted with needed chargers already installed, that's not the case with your favorite Vintage models. The Battery Tender device connects directly to your Bike's battery harness, for an immediate USB port to charge your mobile devices. (Suggested price \$11.00)



4) Eat Sleep Ride—Crashlight Service

This amazing software uses your smartphone's sensor and a highly sophisticated algorithm automatically detects if you are in a motorcycle crash, and unresponsive, and then immediately alerts your identified emergency contact. But the program has other uses as well. It can track your rides, record your GPS route, speed, elevation, and lean angle at any point in your ride. You can even share your route with other ESR users and peruse rides other users have posted, too. (Suggested price \$15.00/yr)



◀ 5) Antigravity Micro-start XP-1 Power Supply:

This little 3"x7" compact battery only weighs 1 lb, but holds enough juice to jumpstart a dead Bike! It has multiple charging ports, a battery level indicator and a 110-Lumen LED flashlight. The kit also comes with mini jumper cables, charging cords and a carrying case to keep it all together and neatly under your seat or in a tail compartment.
